Mitsui Kinzoku Co., Ltd. – Ratio Change and Stock Distribution

Mitsui Kinzoku Co., Ltd. has announced a ten (10) for one (1) stock split on its ordinary shares in the local market effective October 1, 2026. As a result, BNY will change the ratio on the Mitsui Kinzoku Co., Ltd. American Depositary Receipt ("ADR") program from five (5) American Depositary Shares ("ADSs") representing one (1) ordinary share to a new ratio of one (1) ADS representing one (1) ordinary share. The ratio change will occur immediately after the stock split resulting in a 100% ADS distribution (1 additional ADS for each 1 ADS held).

Only whole ADSs will be issued. BNY will aggregate and attempt to sell any fractional ADSs, if any, and distribute the cash proceeds (net of any taxes, fees and expenses) to ADR holders.

ADR Effective date: October 1, 2026

First day of trading under the new ratio is expected to be October 2, 2026.
