Sampo plc's ("Sampo") Board of Directors, at a meeting to be held on August 7, 2019, are expected to give final approval on a distribution of Nordea Bank Abp ("Nordea") shares to Sampo's Ordinary shareholders. Providing that the Board of Directors approve the share distribution, the holders of Sampo ordinary shares will receive the following: 1 Nordea share will be issued for every 10 Sampo shares held as of the local record date of August 09, 2019.

The Nordea shares will not be registered under the United States Securities Act of 1933; therefore we will not be permitted to pass the shares on to the holders of American Depositary Receipts ("ADRs"). As a result, BNY Mellon will be selling the Nordea shares in the local market. The proceeds from the sale of the shares will be distributed to the ADR holders of Sampo. The distribution of Nordea shares is taxable similar to a cash dividend under Finnish law, and is subject to Finnish withholding tax, at a rate of 30%.

The approximate rates outlined below are based on the closing trading price of Nordea on June 13, 2019 –
