

BNY GLOBAL DEPOSITARY NOTES ('GDNs') REPRESENTING COSTA RICA BONDS FEE SCHEDULE

The following fees and charges may be incurred by Owners or Holders (each as defined in the Terms and Conditions of the GDNs), any party withdrawing Deposited Securities or surrendering GDNs or to whom GDNs are issued.

Applicability of Fee Schedule:

This fee schedule shall apply to the issuance of BNY Global Depositary Notes ("GDNs) representing Costa Rica bonds denominated in EUR. The fees outlined herein will govern the deposit of bonds and delivery of GDNs as well as all subsequent services provided by BNY in relation to the GDN program.

(v) Registration or custodial fees or charges relating to Notes/Bonds deposited or withdrawn	Registration/Custodial fees/charges related to Notes/Bonds will be passed through to GDN Owners/ Holders as they are incurred by BNY

(ix)	Fees and charges incurred by Depository or its agents in connection with protecting or securing rights associated with Deposited Securities (including, without limitation, fees and expenses of counsel connected to any default on the Deposited Securities)	Fees and charges that may be incurred by BNY in pursuing rights and remedies related to the Notes/ Bonds will be passed along to the GDN Owners/ Holders as they are incurred by BNY

The Depository may amend these fees or charge additional fees upon 30 days' notice to Owners.

The Bank of New York Mellon (the "Depository") may pay a rebate to brokers in connection with the issuance of unsponsored GDNs; brokers may or may not disclose or pass back some or all of such rebate to investors. The Depository may also use brokers, dealers or other service providers that are affiliates and that may earn or share fees and commissions. The Depository may execute foreign currency transactions itself or through its affiliates, or the Custodian or the Issuer of the Deposited Securities may convert currency and pay US Dollars to the Depository. Where the Depository converts currency itself or through any of its affiliates, the Depository acts as principal for its own account and not as agent, advisor, broker or fiduciary on behalf of any other person and earns revenue, including, without limitation, transaction spreads, that it will retain for its own account. The revenue is based on, among other things, the difference between the exchange rate assigned to the currency conversion made and the rate that the Depository or its affiliate receives when buying or selling foreign currency for its own account. The Depository makes no representation that the exchange rate used or obtained by it or its affiliate in any currency conversion will be the most favourable rate that could be obtained at the time or that the method by which that rate will be determined will be the most favourable to Owners, subject to the Depository's obligations under the Receipt. Where the Custodian converts currency, the Custodian has no obligation to obtain the most favourable rate that could be obtained at the time or to ensure that the method by which that rate will be determined will be the most favourable to Owners, and the Depository makes no representation that the rate is the most favourable rate and will not be liable for any direct or indirect losses associated with the rate. In certain instances, the Depository may receive payment or other distributions from the Issuer of Deposited Securities in US Dollars that represent the proceeds of a conversion of foreign currency or translation from foreign currency at a rate that was obtained or determined by or on behalf of the Issuer of Deposited Securities and, in such cases, the Depository will not engage in, or be responsible for, any foreign currency transactions and neither it nor the Issuer of Deposited Securities makes any representation that the rate obtained or determined by the Issuer of Deposited Securities is the most favourable rate and neither it nor the Issuer of Deposited Securities will be liable for any direct or indirect losses associated with the rate.
